





Instructions:

- 1. Either laminate & write one sight word onto each game space with dry erase marker, or cut out and use the words on the previous page to tape onto each space. (Pick some words your child needs the most work on, and some they know well to play.)
- 2. Cut out the paper dice shown, fold on the lines and tape together. Cut out game pieces.
- 3. To play, each player rolls the dice to determine how many spaces to go forward. Player must spell the word correctly to stay on the space, or go back one space. Player to finish line wins.
