If your child can easily pass several lessons in one day, he can do that, but I'd not do more than a few a day, just to keep it simple and not overwhelming.

Don't continue the lessons if your child isn't enjoying it or picking it up. Instead, wait a few weeks and try again later.

The cat will run quickly.


Quick! Are you going to give me juice or milk?
