Do one lesson each day, repeating it a few times until your child can read the words by himself.

If your child can easily pass several lessons in one day, he can do that, but I'd not do more than a few a day, just to keep it simple and not overwhelming.

Don't continue the lessons if your child isn't enjoying it or picking it up. Instead, wait a few weeks and try again later.

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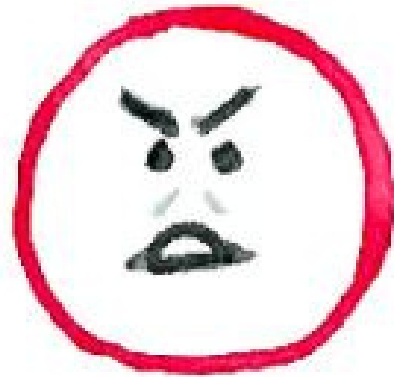
